AIRPORT AUTHORITY (2 vacancies) An autonomous body appointed by the City Council to oversee operation of the Naples Airport. Members of the Airport Authority must be domiciled in the city limits. Terms 4 years. Meets 3rd Thurs. at 8:30 a.m. Average meeting time: 3 hours per month.

Community Redevelopment Agency Advisory Board (4 vacancies for legal residents of the City who are business owners or property owners in the "D" Downtown District {generally the area bounded by 8th Street South to Goodlette-Frank Road and 7th Avenue North to 5th Avenue South}, or the Community Redevelopment Area {generally the area bounded by 7th Avenue North, 6th Avenue South to the Gordon River and 3rd Street}, or the 5th Avenue South Special Overlay District. 7-member board which advises the Community Redevelopment Area by providing public input and technical advice on land use, economic and other issues within the City's redevelopment district, and reviews certain petitions within the district. Terms: 2 years. Meets 4th Monday at 9:00 a.m. Average meeting time: 1 hour per month.

EAST NAPLES BAY CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (3 vacancies for residents within the East Naples Bay District boundaries. Members must live in Oyster Bay, Golden Shores or Royal Harbor.) This committee is charged with the responsibility of making recommendations to the City Council on a variety of issues within this canal maintenance district such as maintenance dredging, canal cleanup, and maintenance of private aids to navigation. Terms: 3 years. Monthly as called. Average meeting time: 1 hour per month.



PUBLIC ART ADVISORY COMMITTEE (1 alternate member vacancy) 5-member board with one alternate that deals with public artwork in the City, including placement, donation and loan of public artwork. Terms: 4 years. Meets 4th Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. Average meeting time: 1 hour per month.

Unless otherwise specified, all members of boards and committees must meet city residency requirements and are subject to state and local ethics laws; some are also subject to State of Florida financial disclosure requirements.
